

Pomfret Public Library – Statement of Concern about Library Resources

The choice of library materials by users is an individual matter, and responsibility for the reading materials of children and adolescents rests with their parents or legal guardians. While a person may reject materials for them self or for their children, they cannot censor or restrict access to the materials by others. Any borrower in the Library's service area who objects to the presence of a work may express their concern by completing the *Statement of Concern about Library Resources* form (below). The Library Director and the Library Board of Trustees will review the challenge at the next regularly scheduled Board of Trustee meeting. While an item is under review it will remain in the collection. The borrower will be informed of the Board's decision regarding the challenge.
